Parking

Murdoch University has plenty of car parks located around the campus. It is a large campus though, so allow plenty of time to park and get to the theatre. A map of University car parks can be found here <http://maps.murdoch.edu.au/show/parking,acrod-parking,bike-rack,bike-shelter,car-park,easy-access-parking,motor-bike-bay/south-street>. As usual, we will have volunteers in **Green** shirts in Car Park 3 (next to drop-off area) selling all day parking passes for \$5 each. Please bring correct change. These allow you to park in a red or green zone parking bay. Alternatively, you can purchase a parking ticket to park in the ticketed parking areas (visitor parking).

Getting there

Murdoch University is ideally located for users of public transport with a number of buses servicing the University including the 99/98, 206, 207, 850 and 851. Murdoch train station is also very close by with regular buses connecting the train station and university.

Alternatively, it's a 15 minute walk.

If you're coming by car, you'll want to take the South St exit from the Kwinana Freeway and enter via the main entrance on South St.
